- 2. Repeat Button Press the Repeat Button once to repeat the current CD track. Press the Repeat Button twice to repeat the entire album.
- 3. Program Button Press the Program Button, in CD mode, to program up to 20 CD tracks.
- 4. Forward/Search Button Press the Forward/Search Buttons to forward the next CD tracks or MP3 files from the USB mode. Press and hold the Forward/Search Buttons to search through a single CD track or MP3 file.
