### Dimensions

(H) 28 x (W) 8 x (D) 8cm

- Colour changing LED - automatically changes through the colours slowly
- Red, yellow, green, purple and blue
- Perfect addition to your, bedroom, living room, dining room or kitchen
- Classic rose shape

Batteries required: 3x AAA (not included)

**ALWAYS USE ALKALINE BATTERIES.  
DO NOT USE LITHIUM BATTERIES.**

### User instructions

The battery compartment is located in the base of the lamp and unclips. Remove cover and insert 3x AAA batteries (not included) as shown and replace cover. Turn the switch to the ON position.

- Remove the batteries if left for long periods.
- Never dispose of batteries in a fire.
