



Change mode

Press B1 to change the functional modes according to the following directions. As you change the mode there will be a "Di" sound depending on how often the button is pressed.



2. Setting the time

Starting from time display mode, press B1 to enter time setting mode. Press B2, B3 to adjust minutes and hours respectively to the correct time.

3. Setting the Alarm time:

Starting from time display mode, press B1 twice to enter alarm setting mode. AL symbol will display with blinking numerals. Press B2, B3 to adjust minutes and hours respectively to the appropriate alarm time.

4. Activate alarm sound and turn on or off the alarm:

In normal time display, press B3 button to turn on alarm sound. The alarm sound will play and the alarm time is shown on the display. It will then return to the normal time display. When setting without alarm sound and alarm function is off, it will make a "DI" sound.

5. Turn on/off hourly announcement:

Starting from the display mode, press B2 to activate (\frown) or deactivate hourly announcement (no Symbol is shown).

6. Snooze function:

When the alarm sounds, press B4 to stop the alarm and start the snooze function. The alarm will sound again every five minutes after the snooze starts. The alarm will sound up to six times.

7. Announce the current time:

In normal time display mode, press B4 button to have current time announced.
