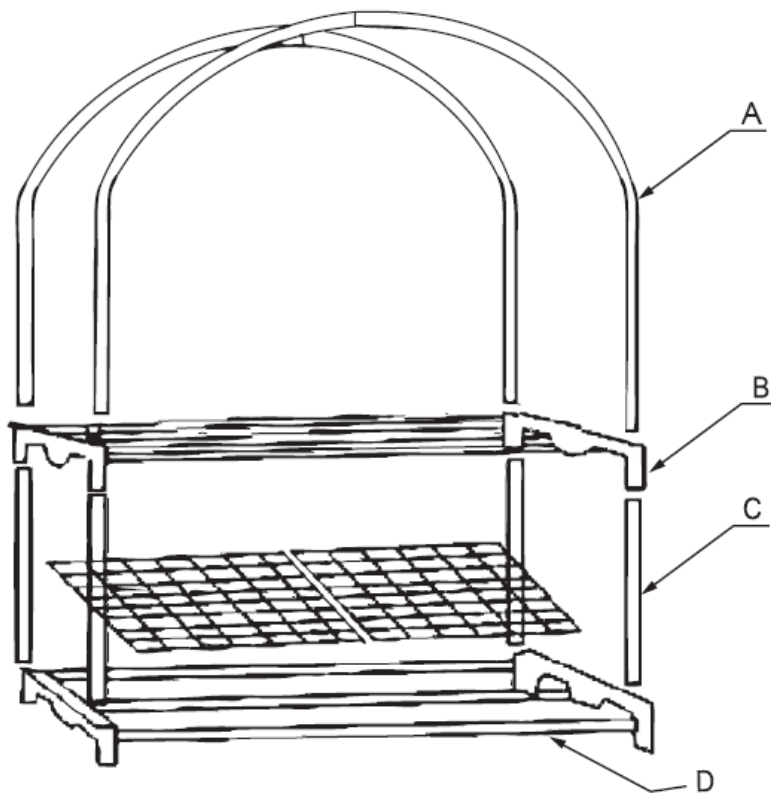




ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS / INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE:

Unpack the components carefully. Please check all parts have been removed from the packaging.

Assemble framework (parts A, B, C and D), then attach shelves (2). Place cover (3) over assembled parts and attach with the ties on the framework. Use ground spikes (1) for more stability.

- Open cover during the day and close again at night. Note: When the door is unzipped and rolled up, it can be held open by the tie provided.
- Place in a secure location and protect from exposure to strong winds, ideally against a wall or fence or use with 4 GROUND PEGS AND ROPES provided TO SECURE INTO THE GROUND. To easily insert stakes into the ground, it is recommended to wet the ground first. To avoid damaging garden stakes when inserting into the ground, select a spot in soft, rock-free soil.
- Protect from extended exposure to strong direct sunlight.

DISPOSAL

- Coopers of Stortford use recyclable or recycled packaging where possible.

Type of Plastic	Low Density Polyethylene
Commonly used for	Shopping bags, bread bags, squeeze bottles, stretch/pallet wrap, bubble wrap, multi-pack can holders
Notes	Usually recyclable supermarket deposit points. Check other plastic films as any non-polythene film e.g. cling film, crisp packets film lids
